WIDOWS' AND ORPHANS' COMMITTEE.

Upon the recommendation of the W. & O. Committee, such change was made in the 14th and 15th Rules of the Fund as would omit all reference to "Ten Years."

Notice of motion was given, (by recommendation of the Committee) of such change in the 11th Rule as would allow holders of certificates to travel within the latitudes usually permitted by Assurance Companies.

It was directed that in future, tables of statistics should state the number of miles travelled.
