Only One Game Played in the American League Yesterday.

New York, Sept. 13.—(By the Associated Press)—The Brooklyn Dodgers picked up ground yesterday by remaining idle while the Giants lost a 5 to 1 decision to the ambitious Cardinals.

The Pirates, who have been tugging frantically at the portals of fame, won a 5 to 4 decision over the Braves, while Chicago defeated the Phillies, 4 to 1.

Aside from these three exhibitions things were quiet in John Heydler's three-ring circus yesterday.

But they were even quieter in Ben Johnson's traveling brigade of baseball performers. The Senators and the Yankees, flying headlong into the final stages of the season, headed due west to open up a flock of crucial series to-day against Chicago, St. Louis and Detroit. The Yanks make a three-day stand in Chicago while the Senators will wrestle for honors against the Detroit Tigers. This series means much to the Tigers and their pennant ambitions will be all wrapped up in this short series with Satley Harris' pennant-bitten regiment of coveters.

But one game was played on the records in the American League yesterday, and that was to St. Louis, 5 to 0, with Cleveland on the losing end.

Garden City, N. Y., Sept. 13.—The chances of the Walker Cup, emblematic of international team supremacy in amateur golf, remaining in the United States for another year were bright yesterday at the conclusion of the four foursome inaugurating competition.

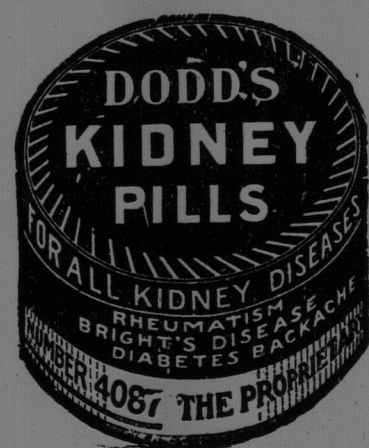
