### Water Wave Mystery

(Montreal Gazette)

Something like a sensation has been created in the technical world by the announcement that the battery discovered principle of wave power transmission, which suggested great purposes in the war, has been applied with definite results of great potential magnitude to engineering operations.

A demonstration of the new science, as applied to mining, shipbuilding and other mechanical tasks is being made at the Dorman works at Stafford, England, and has been witnessed daily during the past week by a stream of engineers, press men, technical journalists and others.

Interest, centred in the drilling of a block of the hardest Cornish granite by a drill driven by water waves, carried at the rate of 5,000 feet second through a flexible metal tube. The experiment was extended to other operations such as riveting, caulking, and the like with equal success, and it is claimed that a new era of untold possibilities in applied mechanics has dawned.

Up to the present five methods have been in commercial use for transmitting power. These are steam, and electricity, and the hydraulic drive mechanism, and compressed air systems. A sixth has now to be added, which opens a new chapter in applied mechanics. This is the transmission of power by waves of sound through water. A Roumanian engineer, Mr. G. Constantinesco, discovered the method and applied it in the first place to aeroplane warfare. Associated with him in its application was Professor R. W. Boyle of the University of Alberta, Edmonton. It was thanks to a synchronizing device based on the principle of wave transmission that it became possible to send two thousand bullets a minute over through the propeller orbit of a fighting machine without risk of hitting the blades.

After this remarkable achievement it was evident that wave transmission might find many applications in industrial economy, and now a well-known firm of Stafford, England, Messrs. H. Dorman & Co., Ltd., is applying it, under exclusive license from the owners of the patent, to a series of percussion and rotary tools for use in various operations where compressed air has hitherto been employed. The first application has been to mining and shipbuilding, where such operations as rock-drilling, riveting and caulking are done. The other have to be done at a distance from the original power plant; but beyond these an indefinite number of industrial uses are envisaged.

What, then, is the principle of wave transmission? The conveyance of power depends upon utilizing the elasticity of the medium—most cheaply and conveniently, water through which energy is to be transmitted.

It is held by engineers that practically incompressible, or at least its compressibility was regarded as having no commercial value. But water is compressible at high pressures, and this fact, so far from being negligible, is of the utmost importance, for upon this compressibility of water depends its power to transmit impulses in waves with phases like those of an electric current.

Perhaps the theory will be best understood by the analogy of the speaking tube. It is not, of course, the speaker's breath which travels until it reaches the ear of the listener, but the waves set up by the vibration of the speaker's voice which move through the air medium. The air itself does not flow through the tube; all that happens to the air particles is that they are subjected to small movements to and fro about the mean position as the sound waves pass along.
