Its position appears to be unanimously in support of the con-tention, embodied in the pending bill, that doubted right to favor its own ships, either by relieving them from the payment of tolls or refunding tolls collected without volating the Hay-Pauncefote treaty. It is recognized, however, that this is a subject that might fairly be made a diplomatic issue, and as the department has declined to enter into any such nego-tiations so long as the subject is unlikely that it will commit itself to any formal statement of its position at this time.
