

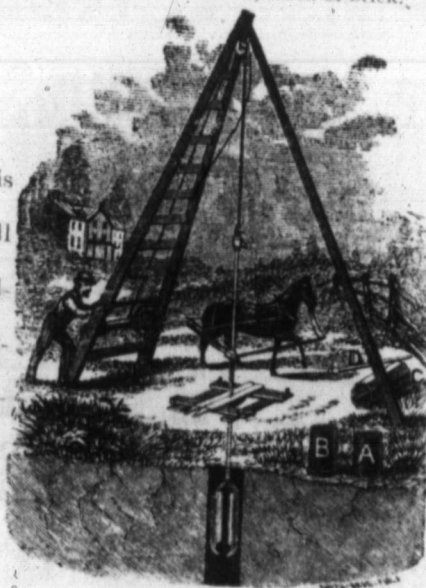

With this machine two men and a horse or three men can bore and wall a 17 inch well in a few hours. We bore any size from 6 to 48 inches, and wall with sewer pipe, galvanized iron, wood or brick.



This machine is the only one that will bore in hard pan sand, stone, or handle quicksand and boulders successfully.

Wells have been sunk with this machine from 30 to 2,300 feet, some of which supply 50 to 200 gals. per minute.

The subscribers undertake to sink wells in any part of the city or country. We can supply more water with 17 inch well than can be supplied with the ordinary dug well, as we can bore into the fountain head of the spring, as it is tubed to the top, no rats, dirt, sewage or surface water can enter the well. We can bore on the bottom of old wells without disturbing the present wall.

READ THE FOLLOWING:

This is to certify that Messrs. Holt & Co., bored me a 17 inch well 34 feet deep, and tubed it with sewer pipe at my residence on Ontario Street. As a proof that all the surface water is excluded, I would state it is only 3 feet from my old well, only 13 feet deep, in which the water is very salty and remains at its old level, and the water in the new well is 10 feet lower and free from any salty or unpleasant flavour.
