19th. Robinson, Jarvis, Hagerman and Strachan's York market monopoly bill passed, 1831.
24th 1832. Disgraceful riot at the Court House of the Newcastle District encouraged by John Brown and others of the magistrates, who enlisted as partisans under orange colours.—26th 1814. The Assembly passed the bill to place Upper Canada wholly under military rule, to suspend the habeas corpus act, by which a person charged with crime has a right to obtain the trial by jury. The yeas were Levius Peters Sherwood, Burwell, Swayze, Beikie, Chrysler, Nichol, m'martin, Fairfield, mears, Young and Stinson. 25th. 1831. Battle of Warsaw.

Corporation for Superintending and Managing the Clergy Reserves—the Bishop, Church of England Clergy, Inspector-General, and Surveyor-General. Secretary, Thomas Baynes. Agents, the Clergy.

Registry-Office. Samuel Ridout, Registrar for the County of York. 18, Newgate Street. This is an Office established by Act of Parliament for the public Registering of Deeds, Conveyances, Wills, and other incumbrances, which shall be made, or may affect any lands, tenements, or hereditaments. Office hours from 9 to 1 o'clock. Fees of entry for every memorial of 100 words, 2s. 6d.; and for every 100 words over and above the first 100, 1s. The like fees are allowed to the Registrar for every certificate of such memorial given under his own hand. Every search, a fee of 1s. 6d.—GOVERNMENT Printer, Robert Stanton, King St.

William Boulton, Second Classical Master. Charles Dade, Mathematical Department. J. P. De La Haye, French Master. [Just as bad—One concern.]

York Infant School, adjoining the Presbyterian Church, Ho-pital Street, formed 28th September, 1831. Miss S. D. Bliss, Mistress. Children of any religious persuasion, under 7 years of age, admitted at a charge of 7s. 6d. per quarter. The School at present consists of 20 or 26 children, and is a most interesting and successful experiment.
