Forty-ninth Annual Report of the Cham-

lotte Co. Agricultural Society.

Another year of the Society's existence is about closing, it now having reached the advanced age of forty-nine years. We feel safe in saying it has not existed for nothing; and although its efforts may have been weak, yet it cannot be denied that they have resulted in good—in so many different ways, that an enumeration of them all, would require the writing of a more powerful pen, than the writer can command, but a few instances may be alluded to. The exhibition created amongst our young men to excel at the ploughing match. The young men now growing up, are yearly becoming more skillful and better ploughmen; there is no doubt that skill and carelessness are as much required in the preparation of the land for seed, as in other parts of farm work. The ploughing match this year was well attended, and the work done gave decided evidence of progress in this direction.

The Annual Fair and State Fair, in various ways, in the yearly bringing together of the Farmers, each seeing as it were, a bird's eye view of the result of the others' labors, and being thus spurred on to increased efforts to excel another season—in the interchange of ideas which then so frequently take place—the mutual imparting of information, as to the methods adopted by each in the raising of good stock—the results of experiments with new seeds, or methods of culture—the benefits or otherwise of artificial manures—the utility of improved implements of agriculture, &c., &c.

The show of animals at the Fair this year was numerically larger, but as a whole was not so good in quality as in former years, although some fine animals were exhibited, amongst which might be mentioned an Alderney Bull, three years old by Mr. W. H. Mowatt. Some good specimens of poultry were exhibited, this being only the second year, in which prizes have been offered for poultry, the result is quite satisfactory.

The samples of Potatoes, &c., and it would be difficult to beat them in any country the show of grains (wheat, barley, &c.) was up to the average. But indoor, domestic manufactures, the exhibition was particularly strong, goods in this line in almost every style manufactured in this country, were given in Flannel, plain and twilled, cotton and wool, and all wool. Cloths, in Satinets, plain and twilled, cotton and wool, and all wool cloths, dyed and natural colors, were all carefully made. Woollen yarns fine and even, spun and twisted, Blankets, Sacks, Mitts, &c., all of them showing marked signs of improvement.

During the year several improved Machines have been introduced into this district, Thrashing and Winnowing Machines, Mowers and Reapers. A Churn on a new principle was shown by Mr. Pettigrove, which he intends to patent in the United States, and the Dominion of Canada.

The farmer as a general rule, has been abundantly rewarded for his labors during the past season, through the blessing of a beneficent Providence, in granting an abundant yield. Potatoes are nearly free from blight, in fact crops of all kinds are generally sound and good.

The directors held the usual meetings during the year, at which efforts were made, to originate such measures as would conduce to the prosperity of the Society's operations, and which were not without success. Thinking the Almighty for the many blessings of which

as a people and as individuals we have been the recipients, we feel encouraged to go on, making no effort, but to do all that within us lies, to diffuse intelligence amongst our fellow men, and inspire them to exertions in every good work that will tend to improvement and prosperity.
