LAST EVENING'S MEETINGS.

Rev. A. B. Winchester, of Knox Church, Toronto, spoke to a crowded house at St. Stephen's last evening. Mr. H. M. Hare led the singing. Mr. Winchester preached on "The Purpose and Law of God." Some men speak, he said, as if the Scriptures were a book of magic. Can you imagine a man looking for a soul with a scalpel, or seeking moral or religious truth by mathematics? You must have appropriate witnesses to decide upon spiritual truths. Sometimes we see the evils of life, but not always the evils of our hearts. This applies also to the law of God. We think it is meant to govern us, yet refuse to abide by it. Several other speakers took part in the service.

Undying loyalty can be awakened only by a person. Creeds and dogmas have in themselves no life and may be a barrier to a man's real religious life. At the close, a large number remained to the after meeting for prayer.

The meeting in North End was divided again last evening into two. Dr. Smith in the Main Street Church addressed the men, while Rev. F. A. Robinson in Portland Methodist spoke to the women. Both addresses were eloquent and stirring. At the close of the Main Street meeting Dr. Smith asked for volunteers who would promise to endeavor to lead one soul to Christ during the campaign. A large number responded.

Gossips and hypocrites was the subject of an eloquent sermon by Rev. Dr. Gray in St. Andrew's Church last evening. The singing was led by Mr. C. P. Allen in his usual able manner. The speaker chose the words of his text from "Luke XIV and 18." "And they all with one voice began to praise him." The speaker dwelt on the evil done by gossiping. The little word dropped perhaps unwittingly often does irreparable damage. He illustrated this point by a beautiful parable and said: "If I were able to reproduce that perfect flower in literature, art or sculpture, I would be famous. But I can't. I can, however, destroy it"—and he proceeded to tear it apart. "Similar is the work of the gossip in the church. It can destroy it, but cannot replace it. He also dwelt on the fact that many people give an excuse for not joining the church, that there are hypocrites in it. That is so, we have them in it, but we should judge an institution not by its failures but by its successes. After the meeting an after service was held which was largely attended.

Dr. Rees spoke to a crowded house in the Clarendon City Hall last evening. Mr. P. A. Bowdoin sang a solo. The speaker took as his text: "It is time to awake." The trouble with some Christians today is that they have fallen asleep too near where they want to awake. The call to awake for religious work was necessary, it must have enthusiasm. Secondly, the pressure of the work demands that we should be awake. Those who enter a cold formal church will become like it. Thirdly, it is only when awake that we are enabled to carry on business, education and the political affairs of the country. So when Christians are awake they are best fitted to carry on the work of the church. In closing he made an eloquent appeal to sinners to embrace Christ.

St. Luke's Church was well filled last night. The Bishop of Fredericton was the speaker. The singing was under the leadership of Mr. A. C. Ritchie. His Lordship preached an eloquent sermon from the parable of the fig-tree.

ANNUAL MEETING OF THE S.P.C.A. HELD THIS FORENOON

The annual meeting of the S. P. C. A. was held this morning in the Board of Trade rooms. There was a small attendance but this does not indicate lack of interest in the work as the year was shown to have been a very encouraging one. Much good work has been done and the treasurer closed the year with a balance on hand.

Among other encouraging features was the report of a new branch at Sackville. The former officers were re-elected with the exception that Mr. W. W. Fisher replaced the late James H. McAvity as one of the vice-presidents.

The meeting came to order at eleven o'clock with T. Barclay Robinson occupying the chair in the absence of the president.

The report of the president, Hon. J. V. Ellis was read by the chairman. The president referred to the marked improvement in the treatment of animals since the society was organized. Aside from the special work in the police court and in warnings and remonstrance to individuals the general educational work of the society has largely affected the community and given tone to its humane feelings. There is a general desire to extend its operation so as to include more actively than it does the care of children. But the president said any case which is noted in treated by the agent as carefully as could be and in that respect considerable work has been done. He did not recommend the establishment of a separate society and referred to the constant warfare of the police magistrate against cases of this kind. The treasurer reported his subscription list for the year ending Dec. 31st, 1909, and closed the year with a balance in the bank of \$105.93. The treasurer also reported on the Sackville branch, which was organized on Dec. 1st, 1909, and reported that the branch was doing well.

On motion of A. C. P. Fisher, referring to the great amount of work done by the professional and other gentlemen present, the auxiliary was paid special attention to seeking the better treatment of animals. The work of the Natural History Society was referred to, and it was suggested that the auxiliary practically taking the place of the Bands of Mercy.

For the year past I am pleased to report that in only six instances have cases of cruelty come under my notice or been reported in writing. Was found necessary to summon the accused to police court, and in every case taken there Mr. J. King Kelly has been present on behalf of the society, and is always ready and willing to give me his valuable advice and counsel in the discharge of my duties. There has not been as many reports of cruelty from other parts of the province as in former years, which I hope indicates that the influence of the society is being felt, and people now realize there is a law that will demand right and proper treatment of the dumb animals. In some cases results have been obtained not only as regards the dumb animals, but in checking many drivers of acts of cruelty caused more by habit than by want of thought. A hard matter to deal with is that of the heavily loaded teams on the ferry boats, especially at low tide, which too often occurs, and in many cases might be remedied by either loading lighter at low tide, or doing most of their work at high tide, the latter might cause too many teams for the ferry boat, but from what has been reported the chairman of the Sackville branch is prepared to put on a second boat to the team traffic is too much for one.
