COURT'S HARD JOLT TO HALIFAX SPECULATORS

Ottawa, Dec. 7.—Judgments in ten exchequer court cases determined the amounts to be paid by the government under expropriation proceedings for property required in connection with the new Intercolonial terminals at Halifax was given today by Mr. Justice Giesela. The total amount claimed by the owners of the various properties expropriated was \$853,920. The total amount offered by the crown was approximately \$250,000. The total amount awarded by the court is \$251,640, or less than one-third of what the owners asked. Most of the cases the court decided that the amount offered by the crown was fair and reasonable.
