Business has been rather more active during past fortnight. Scarcity of money checked speculation, and caused a sharp decline, followed by a reaction. Values remain about the same, with exception of C. P. R., which has advanced 3 points on good returns and covering of shorts in London. Montreal gas broke 8 points on bear selling and tight money, but closes at 156, 2 points above lowest, at which price the stock found friend. Cotton stocks dull and neglected, owing to General Election. There is a prominent bear party on 'Change, and it remains to be seen whether the expected relief to money market due from moving and shipment of grain will counteract the bear movement. Consols touched 114, but receded to 113 1/4, on news from South Africa.
