The collective trade of Canada in Imports and Exports with the undermentioned countries during the Fiscal Years 1871-2 and 1872-3, as exhibited in the following Statement, establishes a steady maintenance of our commercial relations with the Mother Country, and largely increased commerce with the United States. With Great Britain the increase of 19.35 per cent. noted in my last Report as representing our Trade with that country in 1872 over 1871, has been more than maintained, the increase being 20.5 per cent. in 1873 as compared with 1872.
