TREATIES AND CONVENTIONS.

(A.)—DENUNCIATION OF TREATY BETWEEN MONTENEGRO AND GREAT BRITAIN.

The Department of Trade and Commerce has received information from the Colonial Office to the effect that the Montenegrin Government has denounced the Commercial Treaty between that Principality and the United Kindom of January 21, 1882, in accordance with Article XV. of that Treaty. It will cease and determine on the 13th June, 1900.

(B.)—RENEWAL OF TREATY BETWEEN GREAT BRITAIN AND URUGUAY.

A Convention has been entered into between Great Britain and Uruguay for the Renewal of the 'Treaty of Commerce and Navigation' of date November 13, 1885.

Under an Order in Council of date November 4, 1899, the Government of Canada declined to become a party to the Convention.
