

An Act to impose a duty on Foreign built Vessels.

WHEREAS it is expedient to impose a duty of Customs on Foreign built Vessels imported into this Province : Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

Preamble.

1. There shall be raised, levied, collected and paid unto Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, upon every Foreign built Vessel imported into this Province after the passing of this Act, and registered therein, a duty of Customs equal to ten per centum upon the value of such Vessel, to be calculated and ascertained in like manner as other duties of Customs imposed *ad valorem* : And this Act shall be construed as forming one Law with the Act passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, chaptered thirty-one, and intituled, *An Act for repealing and consolidating the present duties of Customs in this Province, and for other purposes therein mentioned*, and the Acts amending the same, in so far as they are in force and consistent with this Act : And all words and expressions used in this Act shall have the meaning assigned to them in the said Acts, and all the provisions of the said Acts, with regard to the duties imposed by them, shall apply to the duty imposed by this Act, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with it.
