An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money required for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government for the financial year ending on the thirtieth of June, 1867, and for other purposes connected with the Public service.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

W HEREAS it appears by messages from His Excellency the Right Honorable Charles Stanley, Viscount Monck, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of Canada, and the estimates accompanying 5 the same, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province not otherwise provided for, for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eighthundred and sixty-seven, and other purposes connected with the public service: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it 10 may be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, that,—

1. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province, there shall and may be paid and applied, a sum not exceeding in the 15 whole seven millions, three thousand two hundred and thirty-six dollars and eighty-one cents, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Province, for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixtyseven, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in the Schedule to this 20 Act, and for the other purposes therein mentioned.

2. The sum of sixty-two thousand dollars appropriated by the said Schedule to this Act, for the Toronto Lunatic Asylum, and the new Gaols in Counties of Lincoln and Frontenac, shall and may be paid, and applied out of the Upper Canada Building Fund, for the purposes 25 mentioned in the said Schedule:---

The sum of nineteen thousand seven hundred dollars appropriated by the said Schedule for certain Gaols in Lower Canada, shall and may be paid and applied out of the Lower Canada Building and Jury Fund, for the purposes mentioned in the said Schedule;

30 The sum of eighteen thousand dollars appropriated by the said Schedule to pay the balance on allowance to County Court Houses, shalf and may be paid and applied out of the Lower Canada Municipalities Fund, for the purposes mentioned in the said Schedule; and
