ARTS

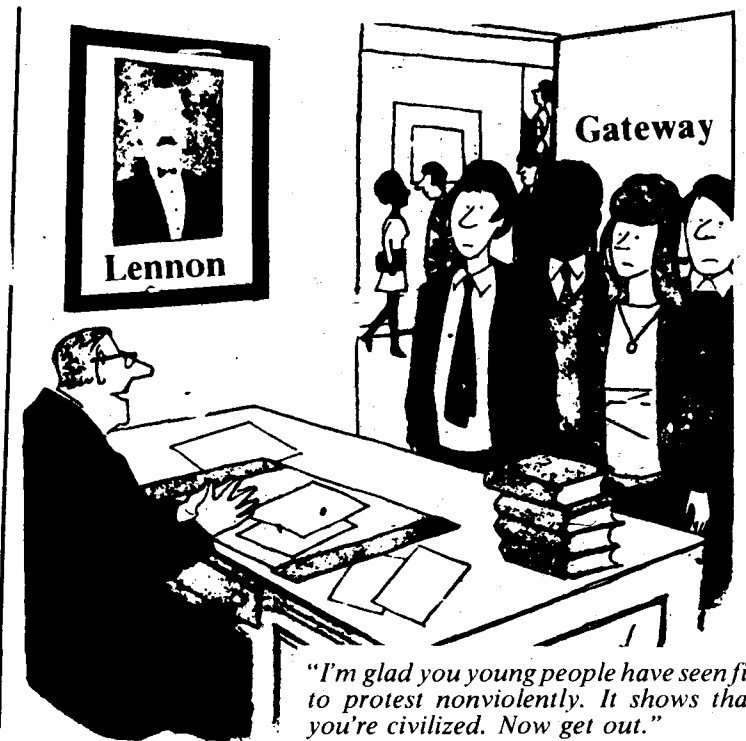
- The Arts section should have more:
