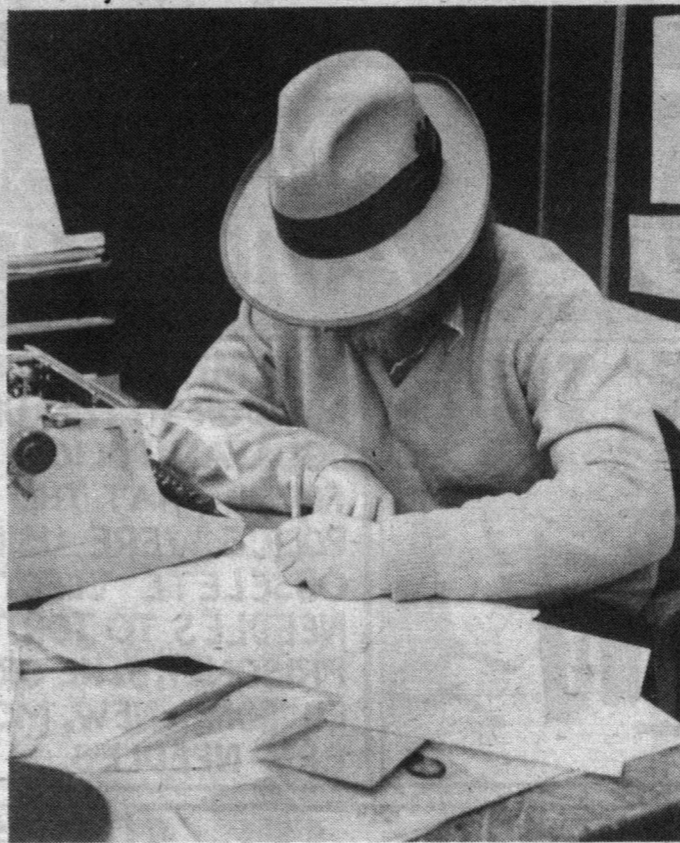

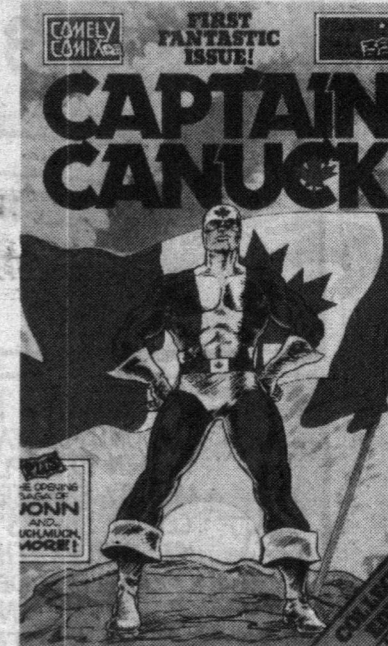
because of artist John Burn," Thomson explains. "If you don't have a good artist it doesn't matter how good the story is."

Some other recent prices as taken from the 1980 *Comic Price Guide* include:

- *Action Comics*, a D.C. title, (with the character *Superman's* first appearance) lists at \$10,000.

- a complete run of *Action Comics* lists at \$30,548. In 1970 the price was \$2354.

- *Fantastic Four* in a complete set sold in 1970 for \$254 and lists



today for \$3570.

- *The Uncanny X-Men* number 94 was released at 60 cents in 1978 and list for \$60 today.

"I still have the same attitude towards collecting," Thomson says.

"I always tell anybody starting (to collect) not to buy *Spiderman* or *Fantastic Four* but buy something they enjoy to read," he advises.

"If you enjoy reading it, you'll enjoy collecting it."
