Disciplinary Code

5. The residences of the University of New Brunswick may adopt the Code for use in their Residence Disciplinary Committees and, where such adoption is made, Division A and E only of this Code shall apply to the Residence Disciplinary Committee. Where the adoption is made by the residence, the jurisdiction of the Code shall apply to a student living in a University residence. A student shall not be prosecuted by the Student Disciplinary Committee if being prosecuted by the Residence Disciplinary Committee for the same offence.

B. DISCIPLINE RE NON-RESIDENCE UNB STUDENTS

When property damage, vandalism, physical violence and injury occur involving non-residence students, either within the UNB residence building or the areas immediately adjacent to and including the outside of these residence buildings, complaints may be dealt with through Campus Security and the Commissioner of Student Discipline in accordance with the UNB Student Disciplinary Code, or alternatively through Campus Security and the City Police through the due process of law.

No student shall be subjected to prosecution for an offence under the UNB Disciplinary Code if he/she has already been convicted of the same or an included offence in a Court of Law.

If a student has been charged with an offence under the Code, he/she shall not be charged by student organizations or the residence system on the same facts under the regulations adopted by those organizations.

C. APPEALS

1. Matters of internal house discipline can be appealed to the appropriate Residence Dean. Any further appeal should not be permitted except in unusual cases, at the discretion of the Commissioner of Student Discipline.

2. Students should be able to seek assistance from the Dean of Students in his/her capacity as Ombudsman if they feel unjustly treated. However, as the Dean of Students is also administratively responsible for the Residence system, appeals from a Decision of either Residence Dean involving breaches of natural justice should be directed normally through the Commissioner of Student Discipline to the President, who may refer the appeal to the Board of Deans or take whatever action he feels appropriate. Such appeals involving admissions, expulsions and readmissions from residence should follow this procedure.

D. PROCEDURES FOR DEALING WITH OTHER THAN UNB STUDENTS

Anyone who is not a UNB student, and who commits an offence in or immediately adjacent to the UNB residences, should be dealt with through UNB Campus Security by the City Police, who will deal with such cases by way of prosecution in the courts as they see fit.
