Town not aware of 'No Parking' signs

"No Parking" signs on Airport Rd., Malton, went up without town council's knowledge, Mississauga general committee was told Wednesday.

Committee will discuss the matter at today's (Wed.) meeting. Council last year approved a request for the signs on one section of the road

but the signs were placed on another section, too.

Committee was told the signs went up as a result of a request from Mississauga police to county council.

Mayor Robert Speck, who said he was in agreement with the placing of the extra signs, has asked county council to defer further action regarding them until it has been discussed at town level.

"Can we be assured that this won't happen again?" asked councillor Harold Kennedy.

Mayor Speck said: "We suddenly heard this and the county council looked at us and said 'don't you know what in the hell is going on down there?'"
