Referring to Official Letter No. 63375-6 of June the 22nd, last, enclosing an account covering the amount of dues payable on timber cut by the licensee in that portion in the Whitefish Lake Reserve situate in Louisa Township, during the past winter; I have the honour to report that I made enquiries into the class of timber cut by the licensee but could not secure satisfactory information, and on the 17th, instant, I visited the portion of the Whitefish Lake Reserve situated in Louisa Township where the licensee has been operating during the past winter and found that under sized second growth timber had been cut and a number of the logs lying in the bush where they had been cut down.
