			Harvard 2616 crashed into Lake Simcoe at 1445 hours, during formation flying. Pilot Officer J.F.B. Martin (J.9859) and Pupil Pilot Aus. 412332 LAC Howarth, F.S. were killed. A heavy snow was encountered and aircraft went out of control and dived into the lake. Cause of accident is obscure pending Court of Inquiry. Next of kin were advised.	
	15-2-42		Squadron Leader R.W. Goodwin (C.1277) arrived from No. 5 S.F.T.S., Brantford, to conduct the Court of Inquiry over the death, in a flying accident, of Pilot Officer Martin and LAC Howarth in Harvard 2616.	
	16-2-42		Court of Inquiry, re aircraft Harvard 2616, was convened. President Squadron Leader R.W. Goodwin (C.1277), Members Flight Lieutenant C.K. Card (C.1345), Flying Officer A.A. Buchanan (C.2624). Pilot Officer J.H. Yocom (C.9799), Educational Officer, arrived from No. 1 Training Command on Temporary Duty, to test W.O. (A.G.) for remustering to aircrew.
