"It does look very much as if we would be able to carry the day", Mr. Burnaby remarked in conclusion. "If we agriculturists realize our responsibility, I am sure that we can easily send a man to Parliament to represent us at the next election. Let us not worry about what Mr. Armstrong is doing or what Mr. King is doing. Let us remember that a knocker never wins and a winner never knocks."
