My dear Sant

Thanks very much for your letter of int. I had not heard before of the Revolution of the Young Conservatives. An very morty they have taken such a step as this.

The Conservative Party under my Leadership will certainly not ignore Quebec. It will be treated with the same courtemy and goodwill as any other Province, and its people will be so treated. The Liberal Press there is trying to raise an anful row and appears to be uttarly indifferent to the plight we are in in this war. The idea, I think, must be to infinitiate the country and especially to intimidate their follow-citizens in Quebec. In the last great struggle, as you more I sever at any time made over a slighting reference to the Province of Quebec, wer uttared a single word to which any sitizes of that Province could take exception. I intend to follow the same course.

We are in the right in this thing, and events of colossal proportions are thundering the truth home day by day. The path of duty is being lighted by the frightful flames of war, and the path of duty for Canada is as clear as moonday.

I songratulate you on the manly and courageous stand you have taken, and I know you will continue it.
