In making Return of dues on
timber cut under license by an
owner of a farm lot, it must be
shown by you that the lot on which
the timber has been cut, is actually
settled upon - otherwise the amount
of timber dues cannot be credited as
past payment for the lot.

In asking for Patent cases,
must be taken that affidavits of
settlement duties having been
performed are furnished. It is not
enough that you state that you are
acquainted with the circumstances
and that you know that the lot is
occupied. But affidavits must
be made in each case by an
interested person that a dwelling
house has been built on the
given
