on the Lot. And yet you allowed
this man to cut pine and
you gave a clearance to Mr
Muir for the same.

You appear to be under
the impression that you and
your Forest Bailiff may permit
timber to be cut in trespass and
that the stealing of the timber
can be compounded and legalized
by your charging without any
reference to the Dept. what
you call "trespass done".

There is no such thing as
authorized "trespass done" - but
when timber has been cut
