- " " 18, Mission.

- " " 32, The Woods Claim.

The said lots are shown on a plan issued by your Department dated Oct. 27, 1904, entitled, "Plan of Settlement at the Fairford Mission Indian Reserve, Province of Manitoba". The remainder of the lots shown on the plan appear to have been laid out for persons who are members of the Fairford Indian Band.

Please note especially in the preparation of the description for the Order in Council confirming this reserve that the lots above mentioned are not to be inoluded; also that the said lots should be dealt with direct by your Department.
