Back on Canada, Mr. Fred Williams writes this interesting iter for The St. Catharines Siandard.
"In 1834 William Lyon Mackenzi ound that he could not act a Mayor of Toronto and editor of the Colonial Advocate at the sam line. Accordingly on November of that year he suspended publication of his newspaper which he has conducted for 10 years. But the text March he lost the mayoralty and replaced The Advocate with the Constitution in which, until

Constitution, one hundred years ago, are worth recalling now that Premier King is being looked to by the newspapers of Canada to defend the freedom of the press gainst Mr. Aberhart's Fascist legis.
