Form for Assembly and Proceedings of Field General Court Martial on Active Service.

PROCEEDINGS.

On Active Service, this TWENTY EIGHTH day of FEBRUARY, 1942.

A.
Order convening the Court.

Whereas it appears to me, the undersigned, an officer in Command of 2nd CANADIAN DIVISION

CANADIAN ARMY, on active service, that the persons named in the annexed Schedule, being subject to Military Law, have committed the offences in the said Schedule mentioned.

And whereas I am of opinion that it is not practicable that such offences should be tried by an ordinary General Court Martial: ~~and that it is not practicable to hold a court of reference or to refer the case to a superior court of law.~~

I hereby convene a Field General Court Martial to try the said persons, and to consist of the Officers hereunder named.

~~and that it is not practicable to hold a court of reference or to refer the case to a superior court of law.]~~ In my opinion, military exigencies, namely the dispersion of units, difficulties of communication and other difficulties, render it inexpedient to comply with those rules inconsistent with R.O. 772 (Appendix "A") on the trial of the person named in the annexed schedule.
