At the General Assembly of her Majesty's Island of Prince Edward, begun and holden at Charlottetown, the Twenty-fourth day of January, *Anno Domini* 1843, in the Sixth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady VICTORIA, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith :

CAP. I.

An ACT for the increase of the Revenue of this Island.

[*Passed, April 17, 1845.*]

WE Her Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects, the House of Assembly of Prince Edward Island, towards raising the necessary Supplies for defraying the expenses of Her Majesty's Government of this Island, have resolved to give and grant unto the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the several Rates and Duties hereinafter mentioned; and do therefore pray your Excellency, that it may be enacted : And be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly,
