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## LATEST MARKETS

LOCAL MARKETS.

London, Thursday, Aug. 4.

Today's market was a repetition of Tuesday's as far as the supply of produce was concerned. The principal part of the offerings were the small products of the farm. Trade was slow and prices were unchanged to any extent. Saturday's market should be a lively one, owing to the fact that on that day the many of the citizens will be attending the Irish Benevolent Society's picnic. Grain—About 30 loads of oats were offered; the demand was brisk; prices were higher, sales were made for the large loads at \$1.05 to \$1.10 per cwt. a couple of small loads were at \$1.00 per cwt. Hay and straw were in good demand; about 30 loads were on the market; prices were very low; about 20 loads were moved at \$1.20 each; prices were from \$5 to \$5.50 per ton; the farmers are simply getting a poor return for their produce, especially when they have had to pay \$1.50 and \$2 per day to men during the last harvest. Straw was dull, at \$5 per ton.

Butter and Eggs—There was no change in prices in this line. Good cracked butter brought 15c to 16c; pound rolls, 15c for the latter half of the week. Eggs sold at 16c per dozen by the basket lot; the dealers are only offering 15c and 16c for large lots.

Fruits—Raspberries were not so plentiful as on Tuesday; the red variety sold at 12c to 13c per box; black, 10c to 11c per box; apples were a drug at 15c to 16c per bushel; pears, per quart, not many offered; red currants, 6c to 7c per box; black currants, 10c per box.

Vegetables and Potatoes—Potatoes were plentiful, at 6c to 7c per bushel; the demand was slow; cabbage plentiful, at 2c to 3c per dozen; tomatoes sold quite readily at 2c for the 18-lb baskets; cucumbers, 20c per dozen; green corn, 15c per dozen; there was an abundance of other vegetables, at prices quoted.

Dressed Hogs—Hogs were made at \$7.50 for heavy and \$7.75 for new lean hogs of about 125 lbs. Poultry—There was a great deal of poultry, was principally in spring chickens, which sold at 15c to 16c per pair, dressed, and 5c per pair alive.

Butchers' Meats—Beef sold at \$5.50 to \$6.00, mostly at \$5.50; pork, at \$5.50 to \$6.00; lamb, 12c per lb. by the carcass.

Hides—Lamb skins have advanced a trifle; this is the only change so far this month.
