That the 7 th by-law of the simstitution of the Society be altered so as to read as follows: "That the society shall hold a general meeting on the second Wednesday in June, in each year, when they shall chonse one or more Vice-President or VicePresidents, in addition to the Archteacon, one or more Secretary or Secretaries, ono or more Auditor or Auditors, and such other officers and sermants as shall be thought convenient for the year ensuing; provided always, that no person not a member of the Society shall be eligible to any office in the same," and that the 8th by-faw be altered ns follows: "the paid officers to be appointed under the foregoing rule, shall be the Secretary or Secretaries, and the Auditor or Auditors, with such salaries as the Society may from time to time appoint, and the Secretary or Secretaries so paid shall furnish security to the satisfaction of the solicitor of the Society to the amount of $£ 1000$. ." Also, that the second clause of the 14 th by-law be altered by inserting the words or "Secretaries," after the word "Secretary," and that the 17th by-law be altered in the same manner, namely, by inserting the words "or Secretaries" after the word Secretnry." The appointments of Clerical and Lay Secretary as made at the meeting held in February were then confirmed by resolution as follows:
