

absence of such markings in no way should relieve any Party of its obligations according to other provisions of the treaty. A norm for physical identification is provided in the 1977 Additional Protocol I to the Geneva Conventions of 1949, annex I, Article 16.

As has been pointed out during the discussions in the Committee as well as in CD/EW/CRP.52, Sweden has only endeavoured to elaborate new text proposals concerning some of the major still outstanding problems. Verifying post factum an attack on a nuclear facility was not thought to be such a major problem, neither was possible alterations in the verification procedures pertaining to radiological weapons in the traditional sense as proposed by the Co-chairman of Party A in CD/111. Sweden would be open to various proposals in these respects.
