Participation by TCC director Planning in Temic 89; sales of \$375,000 of Canadian telecomm and computer equipment to Jordanian clients during quarter

- Major client, TCC, has experienced budget cut and sales will be increasingly difficult. In this quarter, post visited several non-TCC end users in support of Cdn exporters. Sales of C\$ 500,000. were recorded and more expected
