Modification of Canada's reservations to the Protocol for the Prohibition of the Use in War of Asphyxiating, Poisonous or Other Gases, and of Bacteriological Methods of Warfare done at Geneva June 17, 1925

Done at Geneva, **September 6, 1991**

Entered into force for Canada September 6, 1991

Done at Geneva, **June 8, 1977**

Signed by Canada December 12, 1977

Ratified by Canada November 20, 1990

Entered into force for Canada May 20, 1991

Done at Geneva, **June 8, 1977**

Agreement between the Governments of Canada, the United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand and India, and the Government of the Tunisian Republic concerning Commonwealth War Cemeteries, Graves, and Memorials in Tunisia

Done at Tunis, **May 2, 1990**

Signed by Canada May 2, 1990

Entered into force for Canada October 1, 1991
