- 4. The instruments of acceptance of those contracting parties which have signed this protocol, or which have signed it with a reservation as to acceptance, will be deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
- 5. The amendment set out in paragraph 1 of this Protocol shall, upon deposit of instruments of acceptance pursuant to paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Protocol by all the governments which are at that time contracting parties enter into force in accordance with the provisions of Article XXX of Agreement.
- 6. The Secretary-General of the United Nations will inform all interest governments of each acceptance of the amendment set out in this Protocol of the date upon which such amendment enters into force.
- 7. The Secretary-General is authorized to effect registration of this Protocolat the appropriate time.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the respective representatives, duly authorized that effect, have signed the present Protocol.
