majority co-producer. The minority co-producer will have access to the material at all times to make the necessary reproductions, in accordance with the terms and conditions agreed upon by the co-producers.

ARTICLE IX

Subject to the legislation and regulations in force, the Parties shall:

- (a) facilitate the entry into and temporary residence in their respective territories of the creative and technical personnel and the performers hired by the coproducer of the other country for the purpose of the co-production; and
- (b) similarly permit the temporary entry and re-export of any equipment necessary for the purpose of the coproduction.

ARTICLE X

The sharing of revenues by the co-producers should, in principle, be proportional to their respective contributions to the production financing and be subject to approval by the competent authorities of both countries.

ARTICLE XI

Approval of a co-production proposal by the competent authorities of both countries does not constitute a commitment to either or both of the co-producers that governmental authorities will grant a licence to show the co-production.

ARTICLE XII

- Where a co-production is exported to a country that has quota regulations, it shall be included either in the quota of the Party:
 - (a) of the majority co-producer;
