

Goal 3 Promote international security and respect for human rights for sustainable development

OBJECTIVES

3:D Bilateral and multilateral engagement to improve human rights, good governance, and the rule of law as prerequisites for SD, as well as the provision of international humanitarian assistance mechanisms

TARGETS/ACTIONS

- (i) negotiate development of a legal or other instrument (e.g., best practices) to deal with explosive remnants of war (ERW) through clearance operations, recording and provision of information, warnings and voluntary assistance and cooperation (2005)
- (ii) strengthen the voice of Indigenous Peoples in the development of Canadian policies and Arctic Council activities by facilitating their engagement in the processes (2004-2006)
- (iii) implement the strategic priorities for gender equality and women's human rights (2004-2006)
 - increased representation of women in policy and decision making positions in UN and other multilateral and international fora;
 - increased number of UN, international and multilateral fora implementing gender mainstreaming initiatives, including appointment of gender focal points/advisors
 - successful negotiation (and increased co-sponsorship) of Canada-led resolutions at UN and other multilateral and regional fora.
