THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT HIS EXCELLENCY DR. HASSO VON ETZDORF PRESENTED HIS LETTERS OF CREDENCE TO HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL AS AMBASSADOR EXTRAORDINARY AND PLENIPOTENTIARY OF GERMANY TO CANADA. THE CEREMONY TOOK PLACE AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE.

THE UNDER-SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, MR. JULES
LEGER, WAS PRESENT ON THIS OCCASION AND DR. VON ETZDORF WAS PRESENTED
TO THE GOVERNOR GENERAL BY THE CHIEF OF PROTOCOL, MR. E. D'ARCY
MCGREER. THE AMBASSADOR WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MR. H.H. SANTE,
COUNSELLOR; DR. W.O. DENZER, FIRST SECRETARY; DR. EDGAR GERWIN, FIRST
SECRETARY; DR. HANS WEDDIGEN, FIRST SECRETARY; MR. M. ROELLINGHOFF,
SECOND SECRETARY; DR. KLAUS RUSCHER, SECOND SECRETARY; DR. KURT
ANDREAE, SECOND SECRETARY, AND MRS. MARITANA HEINRICHS, THIRD
SECRETARY. MR. LIONEL MASSEY AND MR. J.F. DELAUTE RESPECTIVELY
SECRETARY AND ADMINISTRATIVE SECRETARY TO THE GOVERNOR GENERAL
WERE ALSO PRESENT.

DR. VON ETZDORF WAS BORN IN 1900 AT ELBING AND ENTERED
THE GERMAN DIPLOMATIC SERVICE IN 1928. DURING HIS CAREER HE HAS
SERVED IN JAPAN, ITALY AND IN FRANCE, WHERE HE WAS DEPUTY CHIEF
OF THE GERMAN DELEGATION TO THE INTERIM COMMITTEE FOR THE EUROPEAN
DEFENCE COMMUNITY IN PARIS FROM OCTOBER 1953 TO 1955. SINCE JUNE 1,
1955, THE AMBASSADOR HAS BEEN DEPUTY SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE
WESTERN EUROPEAN UNION IN LONDON. DR VON ETZDORF IS MARRIED.
