## DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENTS

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Paul Martin, today announced the following diplomatic appointments:

Mr. Paul Tremblay, at present Permanent Representative and Ambassador to the Permanent Mission of Canada to the United Nations in New York, to be Ambassador to Belgium with concurrent accreditation to Luxembourg.

Mr. R.P. Bower, at present Ambassador to Japan, to be Ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany;

Mr. John Kenneth Starnes, at present Ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany, to be Ambassador to the United Arab Republic.

The appointments will all become effective during the next few months.
