

but that on the contrary you the said C. D. did retain and occupy the whole of the said beaten track with both the runners of your said vehicle or sled, contrary to the Ordinance in such case made and provided, by reason of which offence, you the said C. D. have forfeited and become liable to pay the penalty of ten shillings, one moiety thereof to be paid to Her said Majesty, and the other moiety to the said A. B. the informer, and which penalty the said A. B. as well for Her said Majesty, as for himself, demands and prays, that you the said C. D. be condemned to pay with costs. These are therefore to command and require you the said C. D. to be and appear before me the said Justice at _____ in the said District, on *Monday*, the _____ day of _____ instant, at the hour of ten in the forenoon, to answer to the said information and complaint, and further to be dealt with according to law. Hereof fail not.
