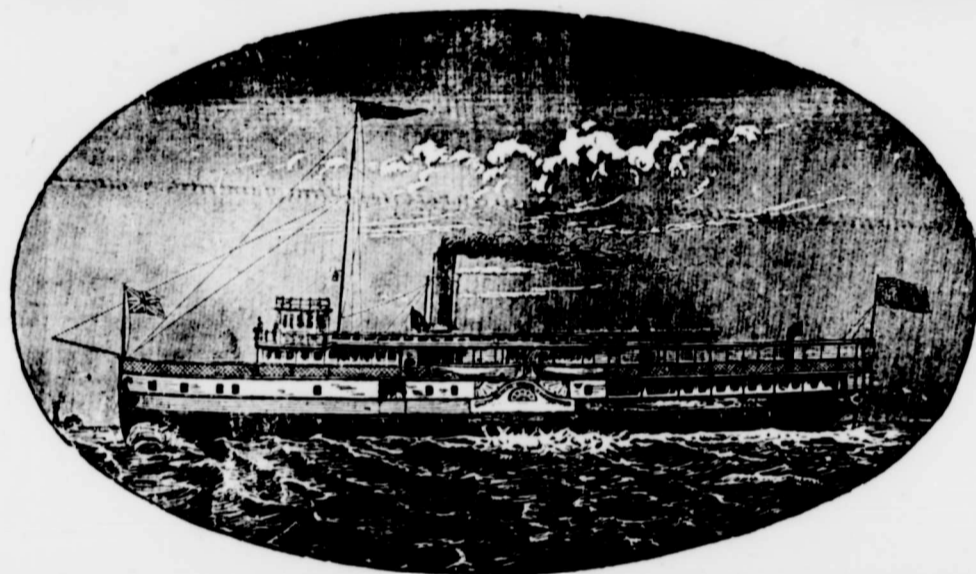


NIAGARA FALLS AND BUFFALO
