These decays require great and conflant repairs, and will confume, if continued, a great portion of the monies deflined to naval purpoles. To avoid this waste of our resources, it is proposed to add to our navy vard here, a dock, within which our prefent veffels may be laid up dry, and under cover from the fun. -- Under these circumstances experience proves that works of wood will remain scarcely at all affected by time. The great abundance of running water which this fituation pollelles, at heights far above the level of the tide, if employed as is practifed for lock navigation, furnishes the means for raising and laying up our veffels, on a dry and sheltered bed. should the measure be found useful here, simi lar depositionies for laying up, as well as for milding and repairing velfels, may hereafter be undertaken at other navy yards, offering the fame means. The plans and estimates of the work, prepared by a person of skill and experience, will be prefented to you, without delay, and from this it will be feen that fearcely more than what has been the coll of one vellel is necellary to fave the whole, and that the annual fun to be employed rewards its completion may be adapted to the views of the Legislature as to haval expenditures.

To cultivate peace and maintain commerce, and navigation in all their lawful enterprife; to foller our fisheries as nurseries of navigation and for the nurture of man, and protect the ma-nufacture; adapted to our circumflances; to preferve the faith of the nation by an exact difcharge of its debts and contracts, expend the public money with the fame care and economy we would practice with our own, and impose on our citizens no unnecessary burthens; to keep in all things within the pule of our conflicational powers, and cherish the Federal union, as the only took of fafety; these, fellow-citizens, are the only land marks by which we are to guide outlelves in all our proceedings. By continuing to make these the rule of our action, we shall endear to our countrymen the true principles of our conflitution, and promote an union of featiment and of action, equally auspicious to their happiness and fafety. On my part you may count on a cordial concurrence in every measure for the public good; and on all information I possess which may enable you to discharge the high functions with which you are invelled by your country

THE MEMORIAL

Of the Senate and House of Representatives of the Common wealth of Kentucky to the General Government.

Having on a former occasion; when we represented the obstructions to the Navigation of the river Mississippi, experienced the attention and juffice of the general government, in providing by a treaty with the court of Spain, not only for the free navigation of that river, but for what, in our remote fittiation from the acean, was absolutely necessary to the enjoyment of it, a place of deposit for our produce. We deem it necessary, barely to flate to you, that by an infraction of that treaty, we are deprived of these advantages in violation of the treaty between the United States and the King of Spain's concluded at San Lorenzo el Real, in Oct. 1795. The Intendant of the port of new-Orleans, has by a proclamation of the 18th of October last, forbidden American citizens to depofit their merchandizes and effects in the faid port, without having alligned to the United States an equivalent establishment on another part of the banks of the Mississippi.

We rely with confidence on your wistom and justice, and pledge ourselves to support; at the expense of our lives and fortunes, such measures as the honour and interest of the United States may require.

Extrait des registres du Sénat Conservateur, du 11 Septembre.

Le sénat conservateur décrète ce qui suit :

Art. I. Les départemens du Pô, de la Doire, de Marengo, de la Scizia, de la Stura et du Tanaro, font réunis au territoire de la république Françoise.

II. Le département du Pô aura quatre députés au corps législatif; ceux de Marengo, de la Stura, et du Tanaro, chacun deux; ce qui portera les membres du corps législatif au nombre de 318.

III. Ces députés feront nommés en l'an l'1; et seront renouvellés dans l'aninée à laquelle appartiendra la férie où fera placé le département auquel ils auront été attachés, à l'exception des députés du département de la Stura, qui ne sortiront qu'en l'an 16.
