#### CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The weather of the past week has been very favorable to jumber activity and we think there has been a slight improvement in the demand. Conservatism still characterizes the action of buyers, however, and there is not likely to be any decided change in the near future, Dealers are not loaded with stock and must continue to buy more or less for requirements. This is about all that is expected during the next two months. The crops are making satisfactory progress and business conditions generally are good.

Late reports regarding square and waney timber confirm the opinion advanced that the outlook is not very encouraging. From what we can learn there appears to be an overproduction. which has come at a time when the consumption is declining. Manufacturers who sold their timber in advance were particularly fortunate, as there has been a decline of fully five cents per cubic foot in the price of waney and a proportionate decline in square timber. The salvation of the market would seem to depend upon a curtailment of operations on the part of manufacturers. If this policy is pursued it should be possible to maintain prices at the present reduced basis, but
