good; I go on because I've started; but what we want in order to set things right is a new religion, and only that can do it.' A new spirit in dealing with the poor is indeed wanted; a spirit of understanding and of patience, and, above all, of goodfellowship. From that the rest, or at all events a good deal of it, would follow, and the problem would begin to be solved the right end foremost.
