The Executive Committee of the Church Association beg leave to submit to its Members a statement of the work in which they are engaged, and in furtherance of which contributions are invited from all friends of Evangelical Truth who desire to maintain the Church of England in its integrity and purity as a Protestant Church.

1. The Protestant and Evangelical Divinity School, for training young men of earnest piety and sound evangelical principles, for Holy Orders, specially merits the yvarmest sympathy and encouragement. The Rev. J. P. Sheraton, M.A., a clergyman of approved piety and learning, has entered on his duties as Principal, at a salary of \$1,500 per annum. The school at present numbers ten young men, preparing for the Ministry, to six of whom a scholarship of \$120 per annum is paid, amounting in all to \$720; and applications from three others are now under consideration. No object calls for more earnest prayer, along with a cheerful contribution of the funds requisite to place the Divinity School on a permanent footing.

2. At the request of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, the Association has undertaken to aid Missions within the Diocese held by Evangelical Clergymen; and engagements have thus far been entered into, with the concurrence of the Bishop, to the extent of \$1,800 per annum.
