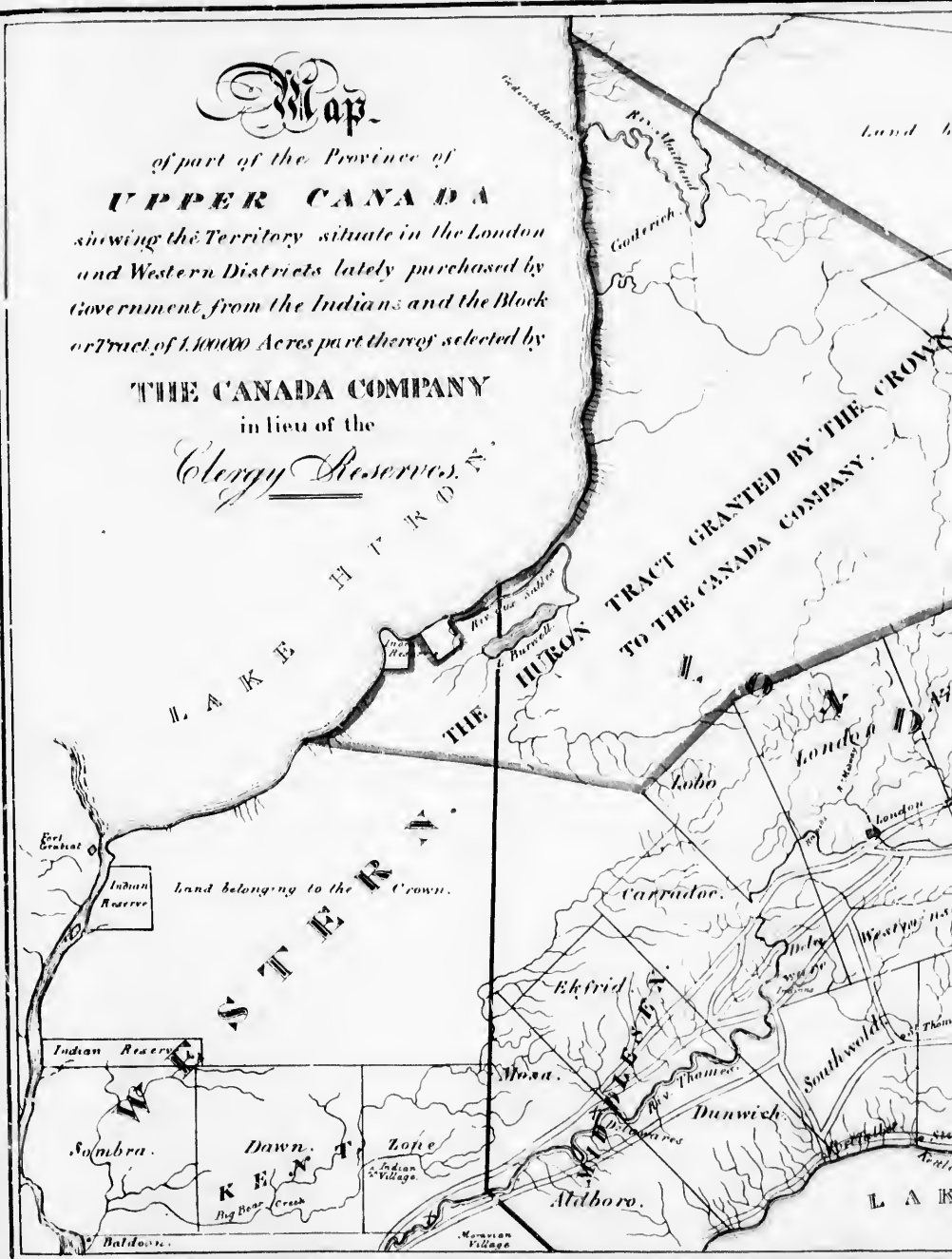



Map
