## Six Woodbine Favorites Beaten Second Choice s and Long Shots

**Tongorder First in Handicap — Breeders' Stakes for Sea Wall — Andrew Summers Makes New Track Record.**

The slaughter of favorites was complete on the third day of the O.J.C.'s spring meeting at Woodbine Park, every one of the six being beaten, and the 300-odd books made a haul. Second choice and long-shot, Tongorder won the Prince of Wales Handicap, being specially prepared for the race. Lord Bonerage beat the favorite, Purlane, in a drive for the place.

The Plate race was run over again as the Breeders' Stakes, with Glimmer as an extra starter, nerving as the favorite. The other eight were all in on Saturday. Kelvin, the winner of the Guineas, had to take up an extra load, and can be excused for running in the race. Photographer was out in front, and he, of course, is the winning pick of the day.

Art Summers captured the first 2-year-old sprint at 7 to 1. Aquiline was the best of the maiden 2-year-olds, winning all round at the largest price of the day—15 to 1.

Seagrass had two favorites beaten, his entry in the second and Purlane in the big race, each finishing third. Glimmer and Suzanne Boncomora were the other public choices.

Warning and Col. Favardale ran outside the money.

Bon Mot by a Head.

The first race of the day had eight starters, with Canopian and Thistle Do split favorites, going to the post at 2-1. Warning had considerable support when he opened at 4-1. Bon Mot was also fancied at 6 to 1, but was played mostly for the place at 2 to 1.
