LONDON CHAMBER NOTES

Will Support Policy of Retaliation, Provided Friendly Negotiations Fail.


(Canadian Associated Press Cable.) London, Jan. 27.—The fiscal plebiscite held by the London Chamber of Commerce resulted as follows: Tax on foodstuffs, yes 74, no 62; tax on raw materials, yes 21, no 117; tax on manufactured goods, yes 116, no 29; reciprocal trade with the colonies and foreign countries on a reciprocal basis, yes 128, no 46.

The chamber will move at the annual meeting of the Chambers of Commerce to support retaliation, provided friendly negotiations fail.
