EMPLOYMENT AND IMMIGRATION REORGANIZATION ACT

MEASURE TO ESTABLISH DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND IMMIGRATION, ETC.

The House resumed consideration of Bill C-27, to establish a Department of Employment and Immigration, the Canada Employment and Immigration Commission and the Canada Employment and Immigration Advisory Council, to amend the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1971 and to amend certain other statutes in consequence thereof, as reported (with amendments) from the Standing Committee on Labour, Manpower and Immigration.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Turner): The House will now proceed to the taking of the deferred divisions on Bill C-27, pursuant to the order made this day. We will proceed with the disposition of these motions in the order listed at the back of today's order paper, followed by motions Nos. 23 and 24 deferred this day.

Mr. Speaker: Order, please. The divisions are on the motions that have been deferred at the report stage of Bill C-27. I have some indication from the hon. member for Winnipeg North Centre (Mr. Knowles) that he has a point of order concerning the combining of some votes.
