The effects of this meeting, were not merely to add somewhat to the funds of the Society, but to revive a warmer interest in the welfare of the D. C. S., and the objects for which it is established. The request of the society that the several local Committees would for this year forego their right to reserve the fourth of their Collections, has been very generally granted.
