foundation. This particular part was about 25 or 30 feet from north of Ald. Lively's office and about two feet from the end of the street ways deeper. He could find several such places in the work. In his opinion the whole foundation was defective.

The ex-inspector went on to say that he would send suggestions before opening four places than the one he did, Tuesday morning. The inquiry here adjourned until 3 p. m. today, when Assistant Engineer Hatfield will be summoned.
